Brooks OPEF VEX Robotics In-House League

OPEF VEX Robotics is excited to announce the launch of a **new pilot program at Brooks with its own competition!**

The Brooks In-House League is designed for the student new to VEX Robotics with little or no experience with ROBOTC programming or for the student who cannot commit to the long season of our Competitive Club. Students will be taught the basics of robot design and programming. They will then work in teams to design, build and program a VEX robot to play in our In-House League competition, **Robot Rumble**. Students will **meet one day a week from 3:30–5 pm** and have 2 sessions to choose from:

- **Fall In-House League:** Tuesdays 3:30-5 pm, 10/03-12/19 (no meeting 10/31, 11/21); Robot Rumble: 12/12
- **Winter In-House League:** Tuesdays 3:30-5 pm, 1/09-3/13; Robot Rumble: 3/10

There is no tryout required to join the In-House League. Students interested in knowing more about this program are invited to attend a Student Interest Meeting after school on September 20 in room B302.
