What is LIT at BASE Camp?

- A mentorship program for rising 9th and 10th graders (must be younger than 16 years old).
- A way to learn leadership skills while working under the supervision of an experienced Youth Counselor and a BASE Camp teacher.
- An opportunity to learn how to work with children in a fun and structured environment.
- Leaders in Training will be assigned to a twoweek, half-day camp, from either 8:45-11:45 am or 12:15 to 3:15 pm. The program runs from June 17- June 28.
- There is a \$50 fee to cover costs.
